

Finding Temple Opportunities Using WoodenVillage.org

1. Find your patron's deceased grandparents:
 - a. Sign in to FamilySearch.org with YOUR username and password.
 - b. Click "HELP OTHERS".
 - c. Enter their FamilySearch Username and Helper Number of your patron. Click "Sign In". The helper number is the last 5 digits of their membership number.
 - d. Review their pedigree. Record the names and PID numbers for the four grandparents of that person.

2. Open a new tab in your browser and go to www.Woodenvillage.org
 - a. Scroll down to the lower right-hand box **Ordinances Needed for Your Relatives**. Click **Select**.
 - b. Type the FamilySearch PID number for one of the grandparents using capital letters and the hyphen (Example: LXSN-KGX).
 - c. Use the default setting for the Number of Ancestor Generation to Search (4)
 - d. Use the default setting for the Number of Descendant Generations to Search (3).
 - e. Click the **Submit** button.
 - f. On the pop-up FamilySearch Sign In window, sign in with YOUR username and password.

4. Scroll down and a brief summary as well as a brown box listing the Ancestors of that grandparent will quickly appear. However, it may take several more minutes for the app to compile a complete list of ancestors needing ordinances.

5. When the report is complete a blue box will show any relatives of that grandparent needing temple ordinances.

6. Click a name of the ancestor to view their Details Page in Family Tree.
7. Determine which ancestor to recommend. Create a Temple Opportunities Report.
8. Meet with your patron and help them get the ordinances done.
